Police Foundations Diploma – Pathway for Professionals Application Instructions

Candidates who demonstrate learning acquired through life and work experience may be granted Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) credit for relevant Humber course(s). Transfer credits may also be granted for courses taken at other academic institutions. Students must successfully complete a minimum of 25% of Humber coursework to be granted a Humber diploma.

Application Process

- 1. Contact the Registrar's Office at Humber College to create a student account. Please be sure to request the Registrar's Office to issue you a Humber student number. The Registrar's Office can be reached at 416-675-5000.
- 2. Complete the Police Foundations Diploma Pathway for Professionals Application Form. The form will require you to include your Humber student number.
- 3. Collect documents that support your application for PLAR credit. These include: a detailed resume and a cover letter detailing how your personal and professional experiences relate to the Police Foundations Diploma Pathway for Professionals. Please include details of any provincial or federal justice training institution you have attended and the year of graduation. You may also include work samples and letters of verification/reference.
- 4. Submit the Police Foundations Diploma Pathway for Professionals application form and your supporting documentation for the PLAR assessment in PDF format to: richard.defacendis@humber.ca. Please submit each document as a separate PDF.
- 5. A PLAR Bundle Fee will be added to your Humber student account. Pay this fee promptly to avoid any delays.



Important Notes

- Please apply early. Sufficient time is required for completion of the comprehensive assessment and processing of paperwork before you are informed of the decision.
 Please allow four weeks for the PLAR assessment process to be completed.
- The PLAR Bundle Fee (assessment fee) of \$300 is non-refundable and must be paid prior to course registration. Note that the PLAR Bundle Fee will increase on September 10th, 2024 to \$450.
- Academic credit will be granted for a course only if learning is assessed to be comparable (in theory or practice) to the level expected from students enrolled in the course/program
- To verify documentation, the assessor shall contact references or employers named in the portfolio or resume
- A successful assessment will award academic credit in the relevant course(s) and the credit(s) will appear on the student record as SAT (for Satisfactory).
