



PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT AND RECOGNITION (PLAR) Application Instructions for Police Foundations Pathway for Professionals Diploma

Candidates who demonstrate learning acquired through life and work experience that corresponds to a specific Humber course may be granted PLAR credit in that course. Transfer credits may be granted for courses taken at other academic institutions.

Process for Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition

1. Collect documents that support your application for PLAR. These include: **your resume and a cover letter detailing how your personal and professional experiences related to the Police Foundations Pathway for Professionals Diploma.** You may also include work samples and letters of verification/reference.
2. Complete the PLAR Application on the second page.
3. Submit the application form and the supporting documents by scan to richard.defacendis@humber.ca

Please Note:

- Credit will be granted only if learning is assessed to be comparable (in both theory and practice) to the level expected from students enrolled in the course/program.
- An assessment fee of \$300 non-refundable.
- In order to verify documentation, the assessor may contact references or employers named in the portfolio or resume.
- Please apply early. Sufficient time is required for completion of the assessment and processing of paperwork before you are informed of the decision. The process can take up to four weeks to be completed.
- A successful assessment will give the applicant academic credit in the specific course(s) and will appear on the student record as a SAT (for satisfied).
